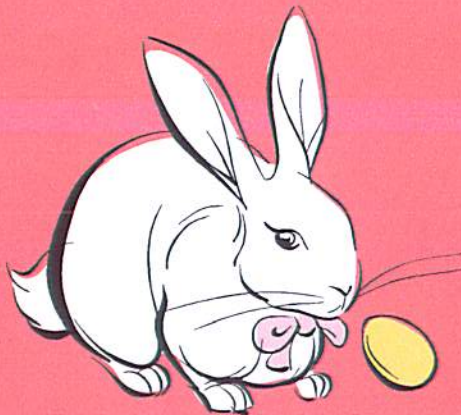
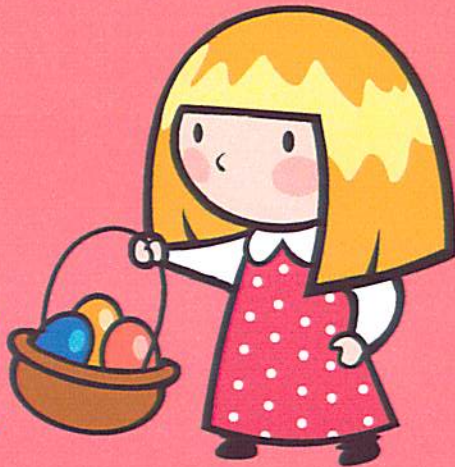

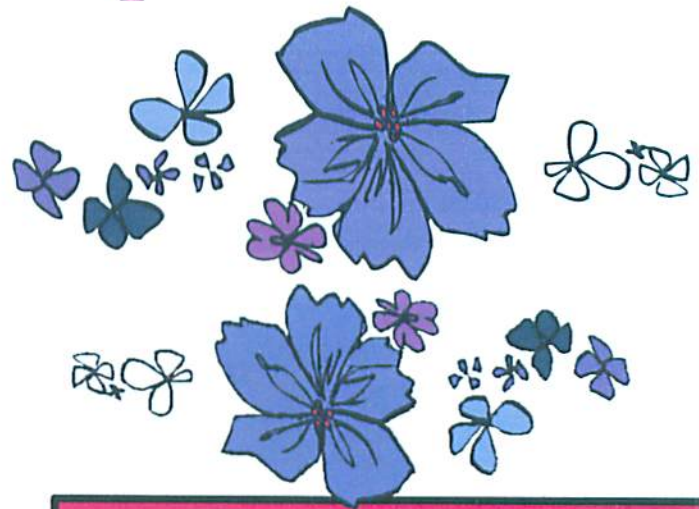

Let's Explore! Vamos a explorar!

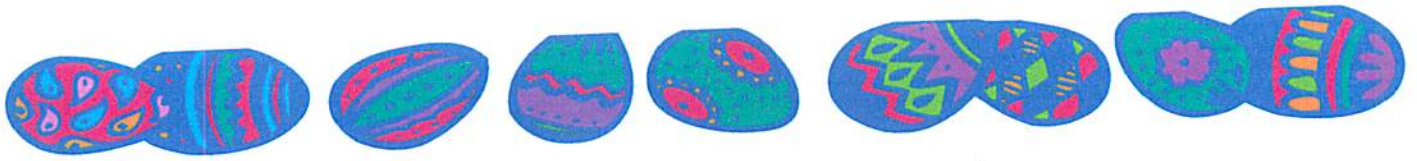
