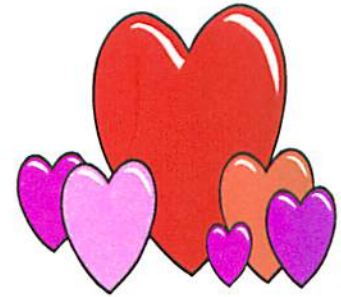

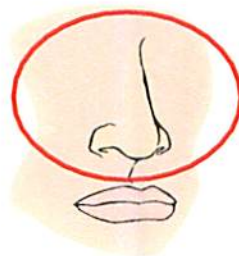
Room #3
