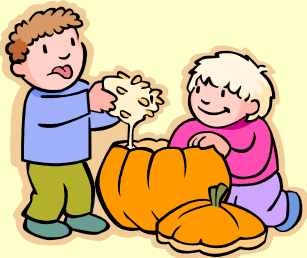

Learn About Fire Escape Plans



In the event of a fire, remember that every second counts, so you and your family must always be prepared. Escape plans help you get out of your home quickly. In less than 30 seconds, a small flame can get completely out of control and turn into a major fire. It only takes minutes for a house to fill with thick black smoke and become engulfed in flames. Every month, prepare and practice an escape route with the entire family, including children. Some tips to consider when preparing your escape plan include:

Find two ways to get out of each room. If the primary way is blocked by fire or smoke, you will need a second way out. A second route might be a window onto a neighbor's roof or a collapsible ladder for escape from upper story windows.

Only purchase collapsible ladders evaluated by a nationally recognized laboratory, such as Underwriters Laboratory (UL).

Make sure that windows are not stuck, screens can be taken out quickly, and that security devices can be properly opened.

Practice feeling your way out of the house in the dark or with your eyes closed.
