TMC Dedicates Safe Haven Building to District Attorney Joe Rubio

Laredo, TX - Having served as one of Safe Haven's greatest champions, TMC honored this evening the work District Attorney Joe Rubio has done during the last twenty years in support of children and the tireless effort to provide the families of Webb and Zapata County a safe environment.

The Jose M. Rubio Building (1115 Chihuahua) houses a family issues program that assists children, in delicate family situations, with the opportunities needed to provide a safe exchange between custodial and non-custodial parents. Also, this program allows for supervised visitations that ensure that children and their non-custodial parent can meet in a safe and secured environment.

The Laredo Webb County Safe Haven Center serves as a child friendly and homely facility used for the safe exchange and supervised visitation of children whose families have been broken by domestic or dating violence, sexual assault, child abuse or stalking.

Background

Representing the judiciary, Judge Oscar Hale, 406th District Court, and Judge Elma Salinas Ender, 341st District Judge, asked TMC to become the managers of the Laredo-Webb County Safe Haven.
